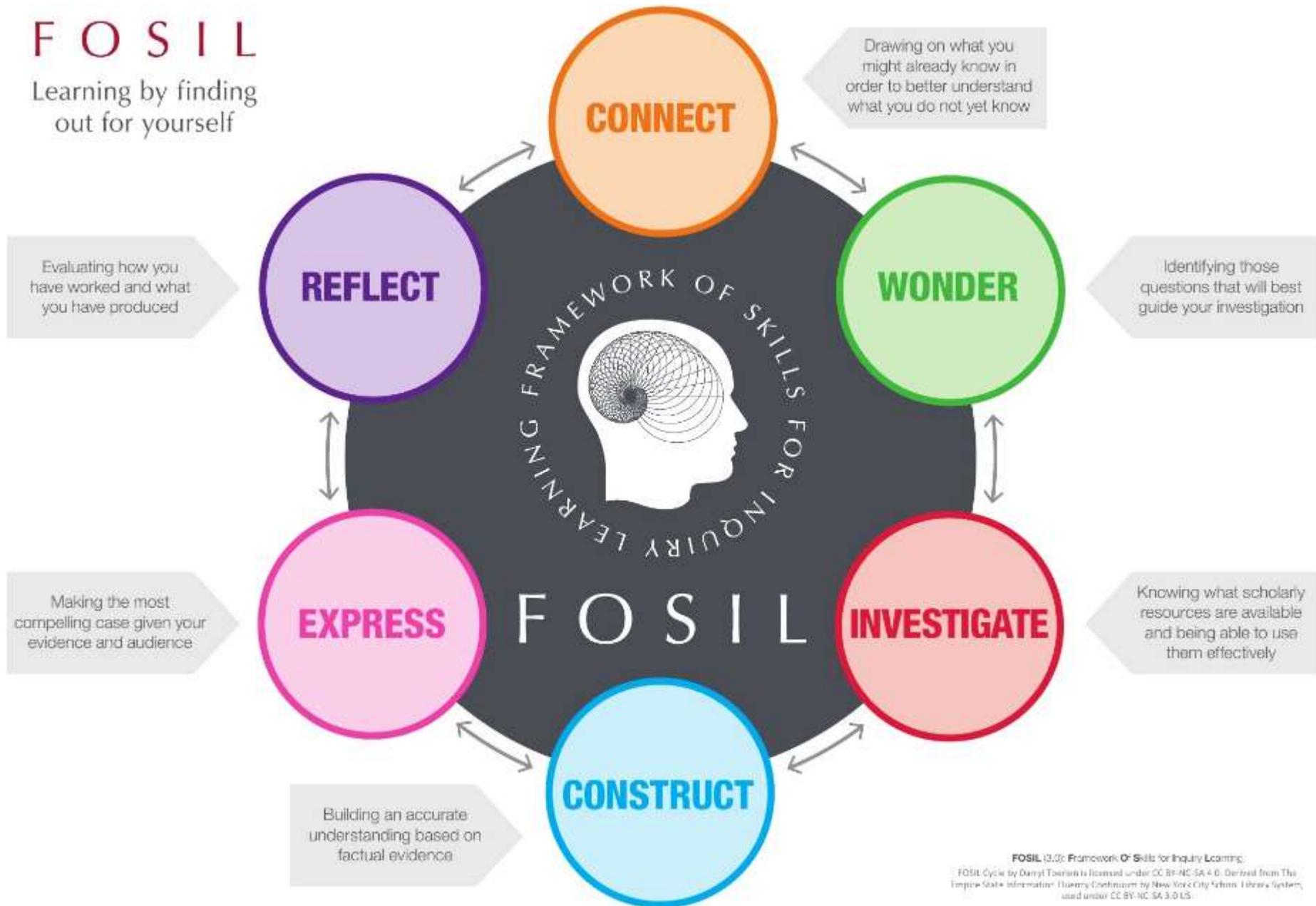

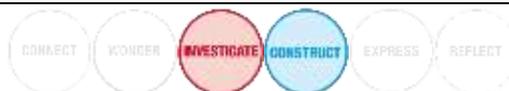
What sort of things did slaves do in Ancient Rome?
